CHAPTER 293

AN ACT to renumber 349.10 (intro. par.) and (1) to (5), as created by chapter 260, laws of 1957 (Bill No. 99, S.); and to create 349.10 (2) of the statutes, relating to the power of local authorities to prohibit turns and 2-way traffic on connecting streets.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 349.10 (intro. par.) and (1) to (5) of the statutes, as created by chapter 260, laws of 1957 (Bill No. 99, S.), are renumbered 349.10 (1) (intro. par.) and (a) to (e), respectively.

SECTION 2. 349.10 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

349.10 (2) No local authority shall declare any part of a connecting street between portions of the state trunk highway system to be a one-way highway or prohibit right or left turns at any intersection of one such connecting street with another without due regard for the expeditious flow of intercity traffic using the state trunk highways and without first conferring with the state highway commission on the problems involved.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1958.
