#### CHAPTER 372

AN ACT to amend 341.14 (1) and 346.50 (2), as created by chapter 260, laws of 1957 (Bill No. 99, S.) of the statutes, relating to parking privileges of disabled war veterans.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 341.14 (1) of the statutes, as created by chapter 260, laws of 1957 (Bill No. 99, S.) is amended to read:

341.14 (1) Whenever any resident of this state who is registering or has registered his automobile \* \* \* *submits a statement from the United States veterans' administration certifying* to the department that by reason of injuries sustained while in the military service of the United States he is disabled by paraplegia, amputation \* \* \* *or loss of use of a leg or foot*, minimum faulty vision of 20/200 or other condition *certified to by the veterans administration* resulting in an equal degree of disability (specifying the particular condition) so as not to be able to get about without great difficulty, the department shall procure, issue and deliver to him, plates of a special design in lieu of the plates which ordinarily would be issued for the automobile. The plates shall be so designed as to readily apprise law enforcement officers of the fact that the automobile is owned by a disabled veteran and is entitled to the parking privileges specified in s. 346.50 (2). No charge in addition to the registration fee shall be made for the issuance of such plates.

SECTION 2. 346.50 (2) of the statutes, as created by chapter 260, laws of 1957 (Bill No. 99, S.), is amended to read:

346.50 (2) An automobile bearing a special registration plate issued pursuant to s. 341.14 (1) to a disabled war veteran is exempt from any ordinance imposing time limitations on parking *in any zone with one hour or more limitation* but otherwise is subject to the laws relating to parking. Parking privileges granted by this subsection are limited to the person to whom the special plate was issued and to qualified operators acting under his express direction *with the disabled veteran present*.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1957.
