**CHAPTER 406**

AN ACT to repeal chapter 384, laws of 1951, paragraph numbered 2 (on page 1794 of Wisconsin annotations, 1950) as created by chapter 45, laws of 1895; and to create chapter 384, laws of 1951, section 2515, relating to the waiving of a jury in the municipal court of the city and county of Milwaukee.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 384, laws of 1951, paragraph numbered 2 (on page 1794 of Wisconsin annotations, 1950), as created by chapter 45, laws of 1895, is repealed.

SECTION 2. Chapter 384, laws of 1951, section 2515, is created to read:

(Chapter 384, laws of 1951) Section 2515. In any case in the municipal court, the defendant may waive a trial by jury by written consent filed in open court or by statement in open court, entered in the minutes, but in all criminal cases, such waiver, in addition to the foregoing, must have the approval of the court and the consent of the state.
