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CHAPTER 555

AN ACT to repeal 200.03 (12); and to repeal and recreate 200.15 of the statutes, relating to the reports of the commissioner of insurance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 200.03 (12) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. 200.15 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

200.15 COMMISSIONER'S REPORT. (1) The commissioner shall preserve in permanent form a full record of his proceedings, including a concise statement of the condition of each insurance company visited or examined by him.

(2) He shall also make a report to the governor each year which shall include:

(a) A list of all insurance companies authorized to do business in this state during the year, with their names, locations, amounts of capital, dates of incorporation and commencement of business, and kind of insurance in which they are engaged, respectively.

(b) A list of the companies which have ceased to do business in this state during such year and the reasons therefor; and of those admitted during the year.

(c) The kind and total amount of insurance carried in the state insurance fund together with the amount of premiums collected, the source and nature of any other income, and the disbursements made. The report shall state separately the premiums, losses, the kind and amount of insurance carried on state property, and on other than state property.

(d) A detailed report of his official actions as ex officio state fire marshal.

(e) Such other information on the general conduct and conditions of all insurance companies doing business in this state as the governor deems necessary.

(3) The commissioner shall have printed not less than 1,000 nor more than 2,500 copies of the report made under sub. (2), in the form and manner determined by him.
