CHAPTER 578

AN ACT to amend 252.155 of the statutes, relating to limitations on public hearings before court commissioners.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

252.155 of the statutes is amended to read:

252.155 All proceedings and hearings before a court commissioner shall be public and every citizen may freely attend the same, *except when*

it is necessary for the court in which the action or proceeding is pending to impose by order restrictions under its inherent power to conduct proceedings in camera.
