CHAPTER 595

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 79.01 (1) of the statutes, relating to the definition of low-grade iron ore.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

79.01 (1) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

79.01 (1) "Low-grade iron ore" means any iron-bearing material in its natural state from which a merchantable concentrate suitable for use in the steel industry can be produced only by a method of beneficiation which:

(a) Increases the percentage of iron content in the concentrate above the acceptable minimum, or

(b) Removes objectionable percentages of foreign materials by fine grinding or chemical process.
