CHAPTER 651

AN ACT granting an easement over certain lands in the city of Platteville to the same city of Platteville for the purposes of public travel.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

An easement is hereby granted to the city of Platteville for the extension and improvement of a street through the campus of the state college at Platteville for the purpose of opening a highway through the present college property for further travel, over the following described property in the city of Platteville:

“20 feet off of the south side of block 65 of the assessment plat of the city of Platteville, Grant county, Wisconsin and 20 feet off of the south side of Lot 28 of Reden’s Addition to said city of Platteville, all according to the recorded map and plat thereof.

60 feet off of the east side of Lot 3 of block 63 of the assessment plat of the city of Platteville, Grant county, Wisconsin according to the recorded map and plat thereof.”

The consideration for the granting of this easement is the agreement of the city of Platteville to vacate and close Washington street between Main and Pine streets in the city of Platteville.
