CHAPTER 657

AN ACT to amend section 2 of chapter 485 of the laws of 1927, as created by chapter 301, laws of 1931, relating to establishing a dock line on Lake Monona, Dane county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 2 of chapter 485 of the laws of 1927, as created by chapter 301 of the laws of 1931, is amended to read:

(Chapter 485, laws of 1927) Section 2. Said dock line on Lake Monona established by this chapter, is hereby declared to be so established only for the purpose of authorizing said city of Madison to construct and maintain on, in, or over said Lake Monona, but not beyond said established line, parks, playgrounds, bathing beaches, municipal boat houses, piers, wharves, public buildings *not more than 20 feet in height*, highways, streets, pleasure drives and boulevards. Said dock line shall in no wise affect or supersede the dock lines on said Lake Monona already existing and established pursuant to law by the said city of Madison, insofar as riparian owners are concerned, and said dock line so established shall in no wise be construed as being for the benefit of riparian owners. Said city of Madison is hereby granted and given concurrent jurisdiction with the state of Wisconsin of and over said Lake Monona and its lake bed between the low water mark or the dock lines heretofore established by the city of Madison and the dock line established by this chapter and said city may bring any action to restrain, enjoin or abate any nuisance or purpresture within such limits.
