CHAPTER 689

AN ACT to amend 49.40 (2), as amended by chapter 228, laws of 1959, of the statutes, relating to state aid for old-age assistance and the percentage of reimbursement to counties for medical care furnished old-age recipients.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 49.40 (2) of the statutes, as amended by chapter 228, laws of 1959, is amended to read:

49.40 (2) Upon forms prescribed by the department claims by counties for reimbursement for vendor medical payments made in behalf of recipients shall be made at the same time and in the same manner as other claims for aid to the blind, aid to dependent children, old-age assistance and aid to the totally and permanently disabled and if approved by the department *50 per cent as to old-age assistance recipients and 35 per cent as to recipients of aid to the blind, aid to dependent children and aid to the totally and permanently disabled*, of such expenditures after deduction of any federal aid that may be received for such expenditures shall be certified by the department to the department of administration as reimbursement to the counties. Any federal aid that may be received for such expenditures shall be certified by the department to the department of administration as reimbursement to the counties. To facilitate prompt reimbursement the certification of the department may be based upon the certified statements of the county officers, provided that any necessary audit adjustments for any month of current or prior years may be included in subsequent certifications.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1961.
