CHAPTER 104

AN ACT to amend 66.945 (3) (a) 2 of the statutes, relating to appointments of regional planning commissioners.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.945 (3) (a) 2 of the statutes is amended to read:

66.945 (3) (a) 2. * * * *Two members from each participating county, shall be appointed by the governor. At least * * * one such appointee shall be * * * a person who * * * has experience in local government in elective or appointive offices or who * * * is professionally engaged in advising local governmental units in the fields of land-use planning, transportation, law, finance or engineering. The governor in making appointments hereunder shall give due weight to * * * the place of residence of the * * * appointees within the * * * various counties encompassed by the region.*
