**CHAPTER 106**

AN ACT to amend 349.08 (5) of the statutes, relating to the erection of temporary school zone warning signs.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

349.08 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

349.08 (5) Nothing in this section shall prohibit local authorities from placing additional stop signs on the roadway *or temporary school zoning warning signs or temporary stop signs in the roadway at school crossings during periods of daylight when school children are using such crossings* if such signs do not interfere with the free movement of vehicles over or about such signs.
