CHAPTER 107

AN ACT to create 946.75 of the statutes, relating to denial of right of person in custody to consult attorney.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

946.75 of the statutes is created to read:

946.75 DENIAL OF RIGHT OF COUNSEL. Whoever shall, while holding another person in custody and if that person requests a named attorney, deny that other person his right to consult and be advised by an attorney at law at his own expense, whether or not such person is charged with a crime, may be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 or imprisoned for not less than 10 days nor more than 6 months, or both.
