CHAPTER 108

AN ACT to amend 348.05 (3) of the statutes, relating to moving over-width farm machinery.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

348.05 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

348.05 (3) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary farm tractors exceeding 9 feet in width and all other farm machinery and implements of husbandry exceeding 8 feet in width may be moved, towed, hauled, by truck or trailer, or in any other manner or by any other means, over the highways of this state by dealers *or farmers* or for purposes of repair without special permit between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays through Thursdays and from 7 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. on Fridays, *but not earlier than one-half hour before sunrise or later than one-half hour after sunset on any day.* Such overwidth machinery shall not be moved on any Wisconsin highway which is part of the national system of interstate highways without special permit.
