CHAPTER 289

AN ACT to renumber 66.047; and to create 66.047 (2) of the statutes, relating to interference with public service structures and notification to public utility of proposed work which might affect facilities serving the public.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 66.047 of the statutes is renumbered 66.047 (1).

SECTION 2. 66.047 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

66.047 (2) Every person intending to excavate, erect a building or structure, make substantial structural changes, or wreck a building or structure shall, before commencing the work, give at least 3 days' notice, not counting Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays, of such intention in writing to all public utilities whose facilities for serving the public might be affected thereby.
