## CHAPTER 61

AN ACT to create 70.11 (22) of the statutes, relating to the exemption from the general property tax of the facilities of the Wisconsin Easter Seal Society used for camps for the handicapped.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 70.11 (22) of the statutes is created to read:

70.11 (22) CAMPS FOR HANDICAPPED. Lands not exceeding 10 acres and the buildings thereon owned by the Wisconsin Easter Seal Society for Crippled Children and Adults, Incorporated, and known as Camp Wawbeek, used for camps for physically handicapped children and adults and not to exceed 371 acres of wooded and meadowland adjacent thereto used in connection therewith, excluding a caretaker's home and 10 acres of land in connection therewith, so long as the property is used solely for such purposes and not for pecuniary profit of any individual.

SECTION 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency appropriation bill in accordance with section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
