CHAPTER 98

AN ACT to amend 341.42 (3) and (4) of the statutes, relating to issuance of reciprocity permits.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

341.42 (3) and (4) of the statutes are amended to read:

341.42 (3) Upon receipt of a properly completed application form and upon being satisfied that the applicant is entitled to reciprocity priv-

ileges, the department shall issue to the applicant a permit for each vehicle for which application is made. The permit shall be in the form of a certificate of registration. * * * If reciprocity between this state and the other jurisdiction ceases to exist, the department shall forthwith cancel all permits issued to residents of that jurisdiction.

(4) Upon being issued a reciprocity permit * * *, the permittee shall display such permit in the cab of his motor truck or truck tractor * * *. Any person who operates on a highway in this state, and any owner who consents to the operation of, a vehicle for which a reciprocity permit * * * has been issued without displaying such permit, * * * as required by this subsection may be fined not more than \$200 or imprisoned not more than 6 months or both.
