

CHAPTER 424

AN ACT to amend the description of land which Chapter 308, Laws 1963, authorized the state department of public welfare to sell and convey with the approval of the governor. (Revisor's Correction Bill)

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Chapter 308, laws of 1963, is amended to read:

Chapter 308, laws of 1963. The state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized on behalf of the state to sell and convey to *Floyd Davis, his heirs and assigns* a parcel of land containing approximately 2.62 acres more or less situated in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 36, T. 19 N., R. 16 E., Winnebago County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

*The south 320 feet of that portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 36, in township 19 north, of range 16 east, in the town of Oshkosh, lying east of the easterly line of County Trunk Highway "A", excepting therefrom that portion thereof, described as follows, viz: Commencing on the south line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ at a point 217.4 feet west of the SE * * * corner thereof, thence north 6 feet, thence northwesterly 80.2 feet to a point 22.5 feet north (measured at right angles) of the south line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, thence north 75° 15' W., 78 feet, thence north 18° 50' E., 59 feet, thence north 78° 54' W., 60 feet, to the easterly line of county trunk highway, thence southwesterly along the easterly line of said highway to the south line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, thence east along the south line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ to the place of beginning, in consideration of the state reserving a perpetual sewage easement 10 feet wide across said lands, the center line of said easement being the location of the state's present sewerage drain across said property, it being understood that the conveyance authorized by this act is in settlement of all matters in difference between the state and Floyd Davis in connection with the property.*
