CHAPTER 493

AN ACT to create 72.065 of the statutes, relating to permitting probate courts to waive interest in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

72.065 of the statutes is created to read:

72.065 COURT MAY WAIVE INTEREST. The court having jurisdiction over the estate may waive the interest on any tax due because of the discovery of property which was omitted in the original tax proceeding. This section applies only where due diligence has been exercised by the personal representative in marshalling the assets.
