

CHAPTER 178

AN ACT to create 60.29 (35) of the statutes, relating to authorizing certain town boards to retain resident physicians.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

60.29 (35) of the statutes is created to read:

60.29 (35) RESIDENT PHYSICIANS. The town board of any town comprised entirely of one or more islands may annually appropriate such sums as the board determines, to pay as a retainer, for the purpose of maintaining a physician as a resident within the town.
