Chapter 594

AN ACT to supersede, for the 1965-67 fiscal biennium only, the 110 session day limit on expense allowances for legislators under section 20.530 (1) (a) 1. f of the statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. During the 1965-67 fiscal biennium, any legislator who has signified by affidavit, filed with the department of administration, the necessity of establishing a temporary residence at the state capitol shall be reimbursed at the rate of \$15 per day for each day in actual attendance at a legislative session of the legislature or a meeting of a standing committee of which he is a member.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this act (1965) shall, for the 1965-67 fiscal biennium, supersede the 110-day limit on expense allowances under section 20.530 (1) (a) 1. f of the statutes, shall be retroactive to cover any such expenses incurred by legislators qualified under SECTION 1 for any expenses they have incurred in attending a session of the legislature or of a standing committee of which they are a member since the 110-day limit expired in October 1965, and shall be prospective to cover any such expenses they will incur on and after the effective date of this act.
