**Chapter 618**

AN ACT to amend 67.12 (12) (a) of the statutes, to permit towns to borrow on promissory notes for the acquisition and development of industrial sites.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

67.12 (12) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

67.12 (12) (a) In addition to the powers heretofore given, any county, city, village, town, school district or town sanitary district may borrow money for the acquisition of lands for public purposes, for permanent improvements of lands, for public work or improvement, and the enlargement or extension thereof, or for equipment or machinery or for general and current municipal expenses, or to provide financial assistance to blight elimination, slum clearance, redevelopment and urban renewal programs and projects under ss. 66.43, 66.431 and 66.435, and in the case of cities ~~and~~, villages *and towns* for the acquisition and development of industrial sites to the extent permitted by s. 66.52 (3).
