CHAPTER 41, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to create 41.01 (5c) of the statutes, relating to the attendance of handicapped children at out-of-state special schools and classes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

41.01 (5c) of the statutes is created to read:

41.01 (5c) Upon advance approval of the state superintendent, the school board of any school district may permit a handicapped child to attend a special school or class outside the state and the county of the child's residence shall pay the tuition and transportation in accordance with the procedure established for the payment of tuition by the county under sub. (5).
