CHAPTER 112, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to temporarily waive certain requirements for foreign physicians to practice in Wisconsin for Dr. Daniel Beebe.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Notwithstanding the requirements for immigrant physicians under section 147.15 (1) of the statutes relating to a declaration to become a United States citizen and holding an immigrant visa, and the requirements of section 147.15 (1m) relating to approved residency and intership, the legislature hereby authorizes the medical examining board to issue temporary licenses to practice medicine and surgery to Dr. Daniel Stephan Beebe of Melbourne, Australia, for the purpose of establishing a medical practice in Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin.
