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CHAPTER 178, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 204.30 (7) of the statutes, relating to cancellation of insurance policies and injured third persons.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

204.30 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

204.30 (7) The cancellation of or the failure to renew any policy for lack of cooperation on the part of the insured is not effective against a 3rd party or parties injured while the policy was in effect unless the insurer can show actual collusion between the 3rd party or parties and the insured resulting in actual financial prejudice to the insurance company.
