AN ACT to amend 116.02 (1) (c) of the statutes, relating to recording the actions of the annual CESA conventions (suggested as remedial legislation by department of public instruction).

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

116.02 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

116.02 (1) (c) If there are more than 11 school districts in the agency, the state superintendent shall cause to convene annually on the 2nd Monday in August a convention composed of the representative from each school board in the agency. *The secretary to the board of control of the agency shall act as nonvoting secretary to the convention. In his absence the convention shall appoint a secretary pro tem from among the representatives to the convention.* Upon the convening of the convention the representatives from all school boards within each union high school district territory, meeting separately, shall elect a single representative to represent the territory in the election of members of the board of control. After the meeting for election of a single representative from each union high school district territory, the convention shall formulate a plan of representation for the agency and shall elect the members of the board of control, not to exceed 11 in number, in accordance with the plan. The members of the board of control shall be chosen from among the representatives elected to represent each union high school district territory and the representatives appointed by the school boards of districts operating both elementary and high school grades.
