CHAPTER 379, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 341.14 (5) of the statutes, relating to special license plates for congressional medal of honor winners.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

341.14 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

341.14 (5) Upon application by any person awarded the congressional medal of honor and submission of proper proof thereof, the division of motor vehicles shall issue special plates so designed as to indicate such award. No charge whatever shall be made for the issuance of such plates.
