CHAPTER 462, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 13.095 of the statutes, relating to review of programs started with federal aid.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

13.095 of the statutes is created to read:

13.095 REVIEW OF PROGRAMS STARTED WITH FEDERAL AID. The federal aid management service under 16.545 shall promptly notify the joint committee on finance whenever any program, financed wholly or partially from federal aids, would have to be continued from state funds because federal aid will be or has been curtailed or withdrawn or because the federal program from which the aid was received has or will be expired. The 2 chairmen of the joint committee on finance shall thereupon schedule a public hearing for the purpose of exploring alternatives with regard to the future in this state of the program for which federal aid which will be or has been reduced or eliminated. The chief executive officer of the department or independent agency administering such program shall appear at the hearing for the information of the joint committee. The joint committee shall submit its recommendations including suggested legislation to the legislature.
