**CHAPTER 494, LAWS OF 1969**

AN ACT to amend 38.20 (3) of the statutes, relating to tuition fees for college transfer courses at vocational, technical and adult schools.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 38.20 (3) of the statutes, as affected by chapter 276, laws of 1969, is amended to read:

38.20 (3) The board shall charge resident tuition at 20% of the instructional cost for state-wide, full-time collegiate transfer courses designated and approved by the state board. Nonresident tuition for these courses shall be charged in accordance with s. 38.19. *No resident of a district which does not have another public higher educational institution within its boundaries shall be charged a tuition fee under this section for attending a collegiate transfer program in such district.*

SECTION 2. If Senate Bill 1 passes the amendment made to section 38.20 (3) of the statutes by this act shall be deemed an amendment to section 38.24 of the statutes.
