CHAPTER 92, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 67.04 (1) (y) of the statutes, relating to county bonds for schools for handicapped children.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

67.04 (1) (y) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

67.04 (1) (y) To acquire sites for and to erect, acquire, add to, improve and equip buildings to be used as instructional centers or special schools for handicapped children under subch. IV of ch. 115; but taxes for the payment of principal of and interest on such bonds shall be levied only against such taxable property in the county which, at the time of the adoption of the initial resolution authorizing such bonds, was included in the county's program for handicapped children under subch. IV of ch. 115, or which thereafter shall be so included.
