## CHAPTER 191, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to create 95.01 of the statutes, prohibiting the administration of drugs to horses for the purpose of altering their performance in a horse pulling contest and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

95.01 of the statutes is created to read:

**95.01 Administration of drugs to horses.** (1) No person may administer a drug to a horse, either internally or externally, for the purpose of altering the performance of the horse in a horse pulling contest.

(2) Persons in charge of a horse pulling contest may require as a condition of participation in the contest that the exhibitor submit his horse for examination by a licensed veterinarian to determine the presence of drugs under sub. (1).
