CHAPTER 286, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 59.75 (3) of the statutes, relating to cash to be kept on hand in populous counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.75 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.75 (3) The county board may fix the amount of money which may be retained by the treasurer but in no case shall the sum exceed \$3,000; provided, that in all counties having a population of 200,000 inhabitants or over, the treasurer may retain such sum as may be fixed by the county board, ~~not exceeding \$150,000.~~
