

CHAPTER 138, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 66.054 (7) of the statutes, relating to license fees for Class "A" retail beer licenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 66.054 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.054 (7) CLASS "A" RETAILERS' LICENSES. Class "A" retailers' licenses ~~shall~~ may be issued only to domestic corporations, to foreign corporations licensed under ch. 180 to do business in this state or to persons of good moral character who are citizens of the United States and of ~~the this~~ the state of Wisconsin and have resided in this state continuously for not less than one year prior to the date of the filing of application for ~~said the~~ said license. ~~Said The license shall authorize~~ authorizes sales of fermented malt beverages only for consumption away from the premises where sold and in the original packages, containers or bottles. The license fee for a Class "A" license shall ~~not exceed \$10 per year or fractional part thereof be determined by the city, village or town in which the premises are located.~~ be determined by the city, village or town in which the premises are located. Not more than 2 Class "A" licenses ~~shall~~ may be issued in the state to any one corporation or person, and in each application for a Class "A" license the applicant shall state that he or she has not made application for more than one other Class "A" license for any other location in the state. No such license ~~shall~~ may be issued to any person acting as agent for or in the employ of another.
