### CHAPTER 433, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to renumber 63.03 (1) (a) to (x); to renumber and amend 63.03 (1) (intro.); to repeal and recreate 63.03 (2); and to create 63.03 (3) of the statutes, relating to classification and certification procedure in county civil service systems.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 63.03 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is renumbered 63.03 (1) and amended to read:

63.03 (1) In every county in which a commission is appointed, ~~pursuant to~~ under ss. 63.01 to 63.16, inclusive, all offices and positions in the public service in ~~said~~ the county shall be divided into 2 classes, namely, the classified and the unclassified service. ~~The unclassified service shall include: All such offices and positions, however created or filled, shall be included in the classified service, except as provided under subs. (2) and (3).~~

SECTION 2. 63.03 (1) (a) to (x) of the statutes, as affected by chapter 27, laws of 1977, are renumbered 63.03 (2) (a) to (x).

SECTION 3. 63.03 (2) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

63.03 (2) Except as provided under sub. (3), the following officers and positions in every county with a commission created under ss. 63.01 to 63.17 shall be in the unclassified service:

(y) Any position of department head under s. 27.03 (2), 46.21 (2) (c), 59.07 (48), 63.02 (2) or 83.01 (1).

SECTION 4. 63.03 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

63.03 (3) Except as otherwise provided in the statutes, if a commission created under ss. 63.01 to 63.17 deems such action to be necessary to secure the best service for the county, the commission may:

(a) Transfer any position of department head, deputy department head, associate department head or immediate assistant department head from the classified service to the unclassified service if the position is in pay range 30 or above. The appointing authority for department heads transferred to or from the classified service under this paragraph shall be designated by county ordinance prior to appointment of any person to any such transferred position. Such appointment shall be subject to confirmation by the county board.

(b) Transfer nonelective offices or positions from the unclassified service under sub. (2) to the classified service.
