**CHAPTER 439, Laws of 1977**

AN ACT to create 176.32 (2m) of the statutes, relating to permitting minors to enter liquor stores.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 176.32 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

176.32 (2m) Subsections (1) and (2) do not prohibit a person under the age of 18 from entering or being on the premises of a place for which a "Class A" retail intoxicating liquor license is issued for the purpose of purchasing edibles or beverages other than intoxicating liquors or fermented malt beverages.
