SENATE AMENDMENT 14, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 64

September 15, 2017 – Offered by Senators Bewley, Larson, Johnson, Carpenter, L. Taylor, Risser, Vinehout, Wirch, Hansen and Ringhand.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
2	amendment 1, as follows:
3	1. Page 322, line 23: after that line insert:
4	"SECTION 379h. 20.435 (5) (gp) of the statutes is created to read:
5	20.435 (5) (gp) Grants for local governments; opioid abuse. All moneys received
6	from judgments from any lawsuits filed under 2017 Wisconsin Act (this act),
7	section 9128 (5w), for the purpose of awarding grants under s. 51.03 (7).".
8	2. Page 550, line 21: after that line insert:
9	"SECTION 976t. 51.03 (7) of the statutes is created to read:
10	51.03 (7) From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (5) (gp), the department shall
11	award grants to county and local health departments that apply for a grant in the
12	manner specified by the department to be used for opioid addiction prevention and
13	recovery efforts and intervention services.".

- Bage 1022, line 19: after that line, after the material inserted by assembly
 amendment 20 to assembly substitute amendment 1, insert:
- "(5w) FILING SUIT AGAINST OPIOID MANUFACTURERS. The legislature requests that
 the attorney general consider the appropriateness of filing suit against opioid
 manufacturers and submit a report to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature
 for distribution to the legislature under section 13.172 (2) of the statutes by October
 1, 2017.".
