**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 4,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 843**

March 22, 2018 - Offered by Representatives CONSIDINE, VRUWINK, NEUBAUER, YOUNG, C. TAYLOR, SUBECK, MEYERS, POPE, HEBL, BARCA, OHNSTAD, SARGENT, BILLINGS, KOLSTE, DOYLE, SHANKLAND, SPREITZER, HINTZ and KESSLER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 3 and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 1m.** 15.374 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

4 15.374 (2) OFFICE OF SCHOOL SAFETY. There is created an office of school safety
5 in the department of public instruction. The director of the office shall be appointed
6 by the state superintendent of public instruction.”.

7 **2.** Page 2, line 4: delete lines 4 to 16 and substitute:

8 “**SECTION 4m.** 20.255 (2) (im) of the statutes is created to read:

9 20.255 (2) (im) *Training to school staff.* All moneys received from fees collected
10 under s. 115.335 (3) to provide training to school staff under s. 115.335 (3).

11 **SECTION 5m.** 20.923 (4) (c) 6. of the statutes is created to read:

1 20.923 (4) (c) 6. Public instruction, department of: director of the office of school
2 safety.”.

3 **3.** Page 3, line 11: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 6q.** 115.335 of the statutes is created to read:

5 **115.335 Office of school safety.** The office of school safety shall do all of the
6 following:

7 **(1)** In conjunction with the department of justice, create model practices for
8 school safety. The department of justice shall provide any resources or staff
9 requested by the office to create the model practices. The office shall also consult the
10 Wisconsin School Safety Coordinators Association and the Wisconsin Safe and
11 Healthy Schools Training and Technical Assistance Center.

12 **(2)** Coordinate with schools under s. 118.07 (4) (cf) and the department of
13 administration to compile blueprints and geographic information system maps for
14 all schools. The office shall keep all blueprints and maps confidential unless a law
15 enforcement agency requests access to the blueprints or maps.

16 **(3)** Offer, or contract with another party to offer, training to school staff on
17 school safety. Training subjects may include trauma informed care and how adverse
18 childhood experiences have an impact on a child’s development and increase needs
19 for counseling or support. If a school receives under s. 115.337 (2) (b) a grant for the
20 training under this subsection, the office may charge a fee for the training.”.

21 **4.** Page 9, line 1: delete lines 1 to 15 and substitute:

22 “**SECTION 19qr.** 119.04 (1) of the statutes, as affected by 2017 Wisconsin Act 59,
23 is amended to read:

1 119.04 (1) Subchapters IV, V and VII of ch. 115, ch. 121 and ss. 66.0235 (3) (c),
2 66.0603 (1m) to (3), 115.01 (1) and (2), 115.28, 115.31, 115.33, 115.335, 115.34,
3 115.343, 115.345, 115.363, 115.364, 115.365 (3), 115.367, 115.38 (2), 115.415, 115.445,
4 118.001 to 118.04, 118.045, 118.06, 118.07, 118.075, 118.076, 118.10, 118.12, 118.125
5 to 118.14, 118.145 (4), 118.15, 118.153, 118.16, 118.162, 118.163, 118.164, 118.18,
6 118.19, 118.196, 118.20, 118.223, 118.225, 118.24 (1), (2) (c) to (f), (6), (8), and (10),
7 118.245, 118.25, 118.255, 118.258, 118.291, 118.292, 118.293, 118.30 to 118.43,
8 118.46, 118.50, 118.51, 118.52, 118.53, 118.55, 118.56, 120.12 (2m), (4m), (5), and (15)
9 to (27), 120.125, 120.13 (1), (2) (b) to (g), (3), (14), (17) to (19), (26), (34), (35), (37),
10 (37m), (38), and (39), 120.137, 120.14, 120.20, 120.21 (3), and 120.25 are applicable
11 to a 1st class city school district and board but not, unless explicitly provided in this
12 chapter or in the terms of a contract, to the commissioner or to any school transferred
13 to an opportunity schools and partnership program.”.

14 **5.** Page 9, line 23: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
15 page 10, line 14.

16 **6.** Page 11, line 7: delete “s. 165.28 (1)” and substitute “s. 115.335 (1)”.

17 **7.** Page 11, line 8: delete “s. 165.28 (3)” and substitute “s. 115.335 (3)”.

18 **8.** Page 13, line 13: delete lines 13 to 15 and substitute:

19 “**SECTION 24m.** 230.08 (2) (wc) of the statutes is created to read:

20 230.08 (2) (wc) The director of the office of school safety in the department of
21 public instruction.”.

22 **9.** Page 14, line 11: delete lines 11 and 12 and substitute:

23 “(1m) OFFICE OF SCHOOL SAFETY; POSITION AUTHORIZATIONS. There is authorized
24 for the office of school safety in the department of public instruction 1.0 FTE GPR

1 director position, 1.0 FTE GPR program and planning analyst position, and, for the
2 period beginning on the effective date of this subsection and ending on June 30, 2019,
3 2.0 FTE GPR project positions to be funded from the appropriation under section
4 20.255 (1) (a) of the statutes.”.

5 **10.** Page 14, line 17: delete “justice” and substitute “public instruction”.

6 **11.** Page 14, line 21: delete “justice” and substitute “public instruction”.

7 **12.** Page 15, line 2: delete “justice” and substitute “public instruction”.

8 **13.** Page 15, line 2: after that line insert:

9 **“SECTION 30m. Fiscal changes.**

10 (1) OFFICE OF SCHOOL SAFETY; POSITIONS. In the schedule under section 20.005
11 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of public instruction under
12 section 20.255 (1) (a) of the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2017-18 is
13 increased by \$91,100 to fund the 4.0 FTE GPR positions authorized under SECTION
14 29 (1m) of this act. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the
15 appropriation to the department of public instruction under section 20.255 (1) (a) of
16 the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2018-19 is increased by \$364,500 to
17 fund the 4.0 FTE GPR positions authorized under SECTION 29 (1m) of this act.”.
