**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 438**

October 24, 2019 – Offered by Representative STAFSHOLT.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 6, line 9: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 12g.** 440.03 (13) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 440.03 (13) (c) The department shall require an applicant for a private
5 detective license or a private security permit under s. 440.26, an applicant for a
6 juvenile martial arts instructor permit under sub. (17), an applicant for a real estate
7 appraiser certification under s. 458.06 or license under s. 458.08, an applicant for a
8 multistate license under s. 441.06 (1c) or 441.10 (1c), an applicant for a compact
9 license under s. 448.05 (2) (f), an applicant for a physical therapist license under s.
10 448.53 or physical therapist assistant license under s. 448.535, and a person for
11 whom the department conducts an investigation under par. (b), to be photographed
12 and fingerprinted on 2 fingerprint cards, each bearing a complete set of the person’s
13 fingerprints. The department of justice may submit the fingerprint cards, and the

1 department of justice shall submit the fingerprint cards of all applicants for a real
2 estate appraiser certification under s. 458.06 or license under s. 458.08, or all
3 applicants for a multistate license under s. 441.06 (1c) or 441.10 (1c), of all applicants
4 for a compact license under s. 448.05 (2) (f), and of all applicants for a physical
5 therapist license under s. 448.53 or a physical therapist assistant license under s.
6 448.535, to the federal bureau of investigation for the purpose of verifying the
7 identity of the persons fingerprinted and obtaining records of their criminal arrests
8 and convictions. Information obtained from the federal bureau of investigation may
9 be shared with the department or the appropriate credentialing board, but shall
10 otherwise be kept confidential and is not subject to disclosure under s. 19.35.

11 **SECTION 12r.** 440.03 (13) (c) of the statutes, as affected by 2019 Wisconsin Act
12 (this act), is amended to read:

13 440.03 (13) (c) The department shall require an applicant for a private
14 detective license or a private security permit under s. 440.26, an applicant for a
15 juvenile martial arts instructor permit under sub. (17), an applicant for a real estate
16 appraiser certification under s. 458.06 or license under s. 458.08, an applicant for a

12 SECTION 12r) and the”.

13 **5.** Page 36, line 13: delete “is” and substitute “are”.
