**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 2**

February 10, 2021 - Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 15, line 16: after that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 25m.** 71.05 (6) (a) 30. of the statutes is created to read:

4 71.05 (6) (a) 30. For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2018, the
5 amount of the deductions in excess of \$250,000 for expenses paid or incurred in the
6 taxable year directly or indirectly from forgiven loans under sections 276 (a) and (b)
7 and 278 (a) of Division N of P.L. 116-260."

8 **2.** Page 26, line 18: after that line insert:

9 **"SECTION 53m.** 71.26 (2) (a) 13. of the statutes is created to read:

10 71.26 (2) (a) 13. For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2018, plus the
11 amount of the deductions in excess of \$250,000 for expenses paid or incurred in the

1 taxable year directly or indirectly from forgiven loans under sections 276 (a) and (b)
2 and 278 (a) of Division N of P.L. 116-260.”.

3 **3.** Page 34, line 19: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 70m.** 71.34 (1k) (q) of the statutes is created to read:

5 71.34 **(1k)** (q) For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2018, an addition
6 shall be made for the amount of the deductions in excess of \$250,000 for expenses
7 paid or incurred in the taxable year directly or indirectly from forgiven loans under
8 sections 276 (a) and (b) and 278 (a) of Division N of P.L. 116-260.”.

9 **4.** Page 38, line 6: after that line insert:

10 “**SECTION 80m.** 71.45 (2) (a) 22. of the statutes is created to read:

11 71.45 **(2)** (a) 22. For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2018, by
12 adding to federal taxable income the amount of the deductions in excess of \$250,000
13 for expenses paid or incurred in the taxable year directly or indirectly from forgiven
14 loans under sections 276 (a) and (b) and 278 (a) of Division N of P.L. 116-260.”.
