



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 700**

November 19, 2021 - Offered by Representative STUBBS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 4: before that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 1b.** 77.51 (1e) of the statutes is created to read:

4 77.51 (1e) "Breast pump" means an electrically or manually controlled pump  
5 device designed or marketed to be used to express milk from a human breast during  
6 lactation. "Breast pump" includes the electrically or manually controlled pump  
7 device and a battery, alternating current adapter, or power supply unit packaged and  
8 sold with the pump device at the time of sale to power the pump device.

9 **SECTION 1c.** 77.51 (1eb) of the statutes is created to read:

10 77.51 (1eb) (a) "Breast pump collection and storage supplies" means items of  
11 tangible personal property designed or marketed to be used in conjunction with a  
12 breast pump to collect milk expressed from a human breast and to store collected  
13 milk until it is ready for consumption.

1 (b) “Breast pump collection and storage supplies” includes breast shields and  
2 breast shield connectors; breast pump tubes and tubing adapters; breast pump  
3 valves and membranes; backflow protectors and backflow protector adapters; breast  
4 bottles and bottle caps specific to the operation of the breast pump; breast milk  
5 storage bags; and other items that may be useful to initiate, support, or sustain  
6 breastfeeding using a breast pump during lactation, that may be sold separately, but  
7 are generally sold as part of a breast pump kit.

8 (c) “Breast pump collection and storage supplies” does not include any of the  
9 following, unless sold as part of a breast pump kit prepackaged by the breast pump  
10 manufacturer or distributor:

- 11 1. Bottles and bottle caps not specific to the operation of the breast pump.
- 12 2. Breast pump travel bags and other similar carrying accessories, including ice  
13 packs, labels, and other similar products.
- 14 3. Breast pump cleaning supplies.
- 15 4. Nursing bras, bra pads, breast shells, and other similar products.
- 16 5. Creams, ointments, and other similar products that relieve  
17 breastfeeding-related symptoms or conditions of the breasts or nipples.

18 **SECTION 1d.** 77.51 (1ef) of the statutes is created to read:

19 77.51 (1ef) “Breast pump kit” means a kit that contains a breast pump and  
20 breast pump collection and storage supplies or other taxable items of tangible  
21 personal property that may be useful to initiate, support, or sustain breastfeeding  
22 using a breast pump during lactation, if the sales price of the other taxable items of  
23 tangible personal property sold as part of the kit at the time of sale is less than 10  
24 percent of the total sales price of the breast pump kit.”.
