WHEREAS, the spiritual and material well-being of a state's citizens is directly related to the quality and character of their physical health; and

WHEREAS, it is vitally important that any program promoting physical activity and sports for fitness must be broadly based encompassing all geographic areas of the state; and

WHEREAS, the success of such a program will be determined by the degree of involvement of capable and dedicated citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable and appropriate to establish a citizen committee to organize and coordinate Wisconsin's program for physical fitness;

NOW, THEREFORE, I WARNEW P. KNOWLES, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby appoint an Executive Committee whose members are William R. Anderson; John E. Erickson; Fred R. Holt; Phillip Hull; Gordon O. Jensen; Leonard A. Larson; Elizabeth Ludwig; Sister Margaret Mary, O.S.F.; Oscar G. Mayer; Allan J. Ryan; Bart Starr; and Vernon E. Woodward; these members will plan and coordinate Wisconsin's program on physical fitness.
