
EXECUTIVE ORDER 2001

WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin is proposing to purchase, for about \$4.5 million, the first unit of what could be a \$15 million computer capable of serving the research and instruction needs of the entire University system; and

WHEREAS, the computer could ultimately extend service to State Universities and provide some specialized services for Wisconsin business and industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WARREN P. KNOWLES, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby establish a Task Force on Computer Services, as a Staff Committee whose membership shall include Hal C. Kuehl, Chairman; Donald J. Atwood; George J. Hess; Wilmer C. Stach; Salvatore Toffanetti; Dr. Mervin E. Muller; Dr. William E. White; Dr. Robert H. DeZonia; and Charles A. Engman, Jr., for the purpose of reviewing the proposed purchase of the computer.
