

EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Council on Criminal Justice was duly established by the Executive Order of the Governor of Wisconsin dated 21 February, 1969; and


WHEREAS, Title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, requires the establishment and maintenance of a state planning agency to carry out the purposes of such Act; and

WHEREAS, such Act requires that each state planning agency be responsible to the Governor of each state; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the State of Wisconsin that the Governor encourage local law enforcement efforts through state assistance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby order that the Wisconsin Council on Criminal Justice shall continue in existence, and do designate such Council the state planning agency required pursuant to the Federal Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, and do invest in such Council all the powers and responsibilities required to administer Title I of such Act, including the power to appoint such standing and ad hoc committees as shall be required, and do hereby direct the Council and its Executive Director to report to the Governor on policy and administrative matters as shall be necessary.
