


EXECUTIVE ORDER 47

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the Senate from the Twenty-Fifth Senatorial District caused by the resignation of the office of State Senator by Arthur A. Cirilli, on the 3rd day of August, A.D., 1972, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, A.D., 1975.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby order that a Special Election be held in the Twenty-Fifth Senatorial District of the State of Wisconsin on the seventh day of November, A.D., 1972, to fill said vacancy, that the Special Primary be held to coincide with the September Primary on the 12th day of September, A.D., 1972, and that said Special Election and Special Primary shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law. The deadline for filing nomination papers will be August 14, 1972.
