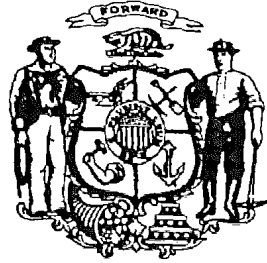


# The State of Wisconsin



## EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of municipal judge for the City of Greenfield due to the death of Judge John W. Foulks whose term of office would have expired on May 1, 1986;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. s. 8.50 and 755.01(1), do order that a special election to fill the vacancy be held on October 25, 1983 and a special primary if necessary be held on September 27, 1983 in the City of Greenfield. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this 12th day of August in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred eighty-three.
