

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3

WHEREAS, Section 14.019, Wisconsin Statutes, provides that under the general powers of the Executive Office, the Governor may create and abolish non-statutory committees by Executive Order; and

WHEREAS, said Section provides that any non-statutory committee created under Section 14.019 shall expire on the fourth Monday of January of the year in which a new gubernatorial term of office begins, unless the new Governor, by Executive Order, provides for its continued existence; and

WHEREAS, persons now serving on such committees remain members until they resign or until they are removed or replaced by action of the Governor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby recreate the following non-statutory entities, effective the fourth Monday of January, 1983:

- Governor's Advisory Bicycle Coordinating Council
- State Historical Records Advisory Board
- Wisconsin Coastal Management Council
- Fox River Locks Task Force
- Wisconsin Advisory Council on Vocational Education
- Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act Advisory Board
- Governor's Committee for People With Disabilities
- Pardon Advisory Board
- Governor's Commission on the United Nations
- Civil Rights Compliance Task Force
- Committee on International Trade
- Wisconsin Statistical Analysis Center
- Ad Hoc Committee on Radiation Disposal
- Governor's Advisory Council on Hispanics
- Governor's Advisory Council on Asians

to remain in effect in accordance with the provisions of Section 14.019, Wisconsin Statutes.
