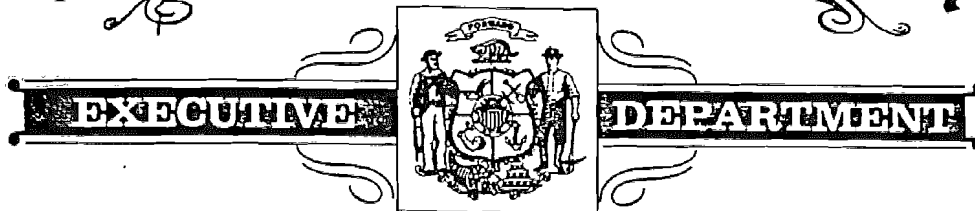




EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 56

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to section 11 of Article IV and section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend Executive Order 55, requiring the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on May 22, 1984 at 10:00 a.m. by adding to its business considering and acting upon the following specific legislative business:


1. Changing eligibility standards and setting income limitations for the financial assistance program for septic system replacement and rehabilitation.
2. Renumbering certain definitions related to taxation and authorizing the revisor of statutes bureau to make nonsubstantive corrections in administrative rules.
3. Making an appropriation for membership dues and related expenses for the Midwest Interstate Low-level Radioactive Waste Compact.
