### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 96

#### (REVISION OF PRIOR ORDER)

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to section 11 of Article IV and section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend as follows Executive Order 95, dated March 21, 1986 requiring the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on March 24, 1986 at 10:00 a.m.:

1. Delete paragraph 2, which provided for creation of an assembly select committee.
2. Amend the time at which the special session is to convene from 10:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
