

## EXECUTIVE ORDER #58

Relating to a Special Election for the Thirty-third State Senate District

WHEREAS, State Senator Susan S. Engeleiter has been selected by President George Bush to serve as the Administrator of the Small Business Administration; and

WHEREAS, State Senator Susan S. Engeleiter has notified the Governor that she will resign her State Senate seat on April 20, 1989;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute sections 8.50 (1)(a) and (4)(d) order that a special election be held on June 27, 1989 to fill the vacancy in the thirty-third senate district as described in Wis. Stats. s.4.009 (33) for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1991, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on May 30, January, 1991, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on May 30, date of this order and nomination papers for candidates may begin on the p.m., May 2, 1989. This section shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
