EXECUTIVE ORDER #63

Relating to a Special Election for the
Nineteenth State Assembly District

WHEREAS, State Representative Louise M. Tesmer submitted her resignation as a State Representative for the Nineteenth Assembly District, effective August 1, 1989,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 8.50 order that a special election be held on October 17, 1989 to fill the vacancy in the Nineteenth Assembly District as described in Wis. Stats. s.4.19 for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1991, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on September 19, 1989. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., August 22, 1989. This section shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
