



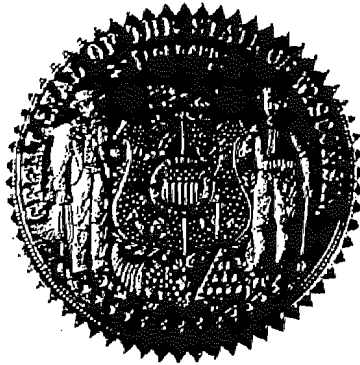

EXECUTIVE ORDER #72

Relating to amending Executive Orders #67 (dated 9/29/89)  
and #70 (dated 10/10/89) to expand a Special  
Session of the Legislature.

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article IV, section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin do amend Executive Orders #67 (dated 9/29/89) and #70 (dated 10/10/89), which required the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison on Tuesday, October 10, 1989 at 10:00 a.m., by adding to its business consideration and action upon the following specific legislative business:

To enact legislation relating to expanding the farmland tax credit to include improvements, increasing the maximum credit and making appropriations.
